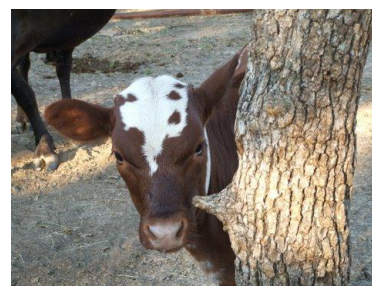

March 23-25 American Miniature Horse Show "Spring Show"

Today's Miniature Horses are bred for superb conformation and outstanding dispositions. The result is a beautifully proportionate little horse that is suitable to a variety of uses. Miniature Horses also require similar care to full size horse, but based on their size they require much less space. Dwindling land resources have also contributed to the Miniature Horses' growing popularity. Miniature Horses are also rarely shod. They are shown without shoes and require only regularly trimming to keep their hooves in good form. Miniature therapy horses however often wear "mini-sneakers" to keep them from slipping on the linoleum or wood floors when they visit hospitals, nursing homes and schools.



Minatures are well suited for everyone from the novice horseperson to the consummate show professional. Miniature Horses are extremely versatile. Their roles vary from backyard pet, to gorgeous show horses to therapy horses for persons with special needs and companions to the elderly. Whatever your interest in horses, it is likely there is a Miniature Horse suitable for the job!
