Millennium Longhorn Futurity June 3-4

The main goal of the Millennium Futurity is to promote the Texas Longhorn by displaying "animals of value" and to have some fun in the process. The Futurity allows people to show off their best animals and have a chance to win money and prizes. It also affords everyone an opportunity to see what other breeders are producing. Any animal to be shown or sold at the Millennium Futurity must first meet the eligibility requirements. In order to be eligible, the animal must be registered with the Texas Longhorn Breeders Association of America (TLBAA) or the International Texas Longhorn Association (ITLA), and must have been owned by a Millennium Futurity partner since the date that partner joined. In addition, any offspring that an animal has after the time it becomes Futurity eligible is considered eligible. This allows people who are not partners in the Futurity to participate in the show once they've purchased an animal that is already eligible.

To qualify for the finals: At each of these three races the top 10 in each division from each day (Saturday and Sunday) will earn their spot in the "\$2500 Added Extreme Winning Tour Semi-Finals" held in September. That will be 100 a weekend, 300 total going to the semi-finals. You can only qualify one time/one position; if you qualify more than once your position will move to the next person eligible. Qualifying is based on rider and not horse. You may ride any horse you choose in the semi-finals.

The top 10 in each division from the semi-finals will advance to the \$2500 added "Extreme Winning Tour Finals." Saddles will be given to each division winner, along with prizes to all of the finalists. Anyone who qualifies for the Semi's and Finals can carry their times over to the Open 5D race each night. (Open Entry Fee must be paid.)
